PCCOA also provides an active Senior Center where individuals over the age of 60 may come to socialize, participate in a wide variety of activities, and eat a well balanced lunch.

PCCOA receives less than 36% of its annual budget from federal and state resources. **The rest comes from you, the citizens of Parker County.**

Through your gifts, honorariums, memorials and participation in fund raising events, no one over the age of 60 is denied services for inability to pay.

SENIOR CENTER LUNCH

Served five days a week in a congregate setting at the Weatherford Senior Center. These meals meet 1/3 of the Recommended Daily Allowance requirements for senior adults.

MEALS ON WHEELS

Delivered five days a week to homebound elderly who are unable to prepare their own meals or who lack family, friends or other community resources.

TRANSPORTATION

Available Monday through Friday, this service offers reduced rates for trips to various locations in Parker County such as pharmacies, doctor's offices, grocery stores and the Senior Center.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Senior Citizens may receive up to \$60 toward a utility bill and/or prescription costs annually.

LIQUID NUTRITION

Ensure is available to clients once per month at no cost.
